Real Marriage for Real People
Eph. 5:21-33

Mutual submission is the foundation for all gospel focused relationships.

4 ideas from this passage

1. Marriage needs a new perspective.
 - marriage is a relationship of constant reconciliation.
 - it's an earthly example of an eternal reality.
2. Submission and Leadership
 - submission: allowing your husband to lead
 - leadership: moving your wife onto God's agenda
 - spouses are given the joyful and serious responsibility of caring for one another's soul.
3. Christ-like Love and Sacrifice
 - sacrifice: allowing someone else to have priority
 - A healthy marriage is a witness of the gospel
4. Lifelong Commitment
 - The marriage covenant is to serve my spouse in the journey of faithfulness to Christ and in pursuit of His mission.
