## Adult Life Group Leader Training

**Saturday, January 12 at 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM**

All leaders of Adult Life Groups will join together for a focused time of prayer and training for healthy Life Groups in the new year.

**As we begin 2019, I've got three challenges for you.**

**1. Bible Engagement.** The number one factor for growth in a Christian's life is their level of Bible study. The great Christian leader and prayer warrior George Muller once stated, "The vigor of our spiritual life will be in direct proportion to the place held by our Bible in our life and thoughts." Let me encourage you to use a Bible reading plan in 2019. If you do not have one yet, download the Foundation 260 Plan from Replicate Ministries. Make it your goal to engage the Bible daily throughout the year.

**2. Dinner with Friends.** Each of us have friends, neighbors, coworkers, and acquaintances that are unchurched, de-churched, and never-churched. Because they may have some hesitation about attending a Bible study or worship service, invite them to your dinner table. As we've navigated through a difficult 2018 as a church with declining attendance, there is a key factor that can immediately change our trajectory: personal investment in friendships with the lost and unchurched. Your sincere friendship with the lost will allow you to introduce them to the life of the church and new life in Christ. Make it your aim in 2019 to invest in friendships with people separated from Christ.

**3. Life Group Involvement.** Life Groups are our ongoing Bible study groups where you connect to a group of friends to study the Word, pray, care for each other, and get involved in ministry together. We have Life Groups that meet on Sunday morning and various nights of the week. If you're not in a Life Group, let us help you get plugged in. If you've been in one for a while, consider helping the church launch a new one. The more Life Groups we have, the more opportunities we offer for connections. Plan on being a part of a growing and multiplying Life Group in 2019.
