VBS-In the Wild

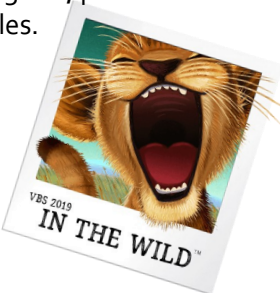
Monday, June 10 to Friday, June 15

Often I remind myself that our leadership is merely temporary stewardship, that God in His providence has put us in our roles for a season. The ministry is ultimately His, not ours.


Moses prayed, "Lord, teach us to number our days carefully so that we may develop wisdom in our hearts."

SUMMER GIVING CHALLENGE

Summer is upon us. It's a great time for families and ministry. It's also known to be a season of financial slump for churches. We can all play a role in avoiding the typical church financial slump.

To avoid that, we have created the **Summer Giving Challenge**. The challenge is two-fold: **participate & increase**. We are asking God not to just help us maintain but to actually bless us with an increase. The challenge for this summer is to reach \$300,000.

Your family can participate by asking God how you can give more this summer. For your family, that might mean you just give more routinely. It may mean giving in the same rhythm but just adding more to each gift. It could mean that God blesses you where you can give a lump sum beyond your regular tithe. For all of us, it could mean taking a proactive step by giving online when you are away on vacation.
